Teeth help to break down food ready to be swallowed and digested.	Different types of teeth bite, tear and crush our food.
Canines grip and tear our food.	We lose our teeth at about 6 years old ready for our adult teeth to appear.
Teeth start to appear when we are about 5 or 6 months of age.	Molars are the big strong back teeth, which crush our food.
Babies' teeth are called milk teeth.	If bits of food are stuck between our teeth acid is produced and tooth decay may occur.
The enamel is the hard outer layer of our teeth.	To keep our teeth healthy, we should brush our teeth twice a day.
Milk helps our teeth to be healthy because it contains calcium.	Incisors bite and cut our food.
All humans have 100 teeth.	We do not need to brush our teeth because they will keep on growing
You should visit your dentist twice a year.	Adults have 32 teeth.
Sweets are good for your teeth and the sugar protects the enamel.	Sweets help acid to build up in our teeth and this may lead to tooth decay
